Mid-Week Bible Study – February 9, 2022

Topic: Working Faith Over Situations/Circumstances **Text:** Hebrews 11:30-38

Introduction: Today our study focused on exploring the impact of living faith in Christ. Christians' walks with God do not remove us from challenging situations and circumstances of life. There Scripture is loaded with challenging situations and hard times in the lives of Christians. Jesus experienced and tasted with hard times. But in all these, God manifested His power in all situations. Living Christian faith proves Satan fallacy that men ONLY serve God for what they get from Him (John 1:8-11).

Discussion Questions:

1. Name situations/circumstances over which God's Power was manifested (Heb. 11:30-38).
2. How did God demonstrate his loving power over situation/circumstances? (Dan 3:18-25; 6:16-22; Luke 10:17-21).
3. What are the lessons we can learned from God's manifestation of power from (Dan. 3:18-25; Dan. 6:16-22; Luke 10:17-21).
4. From what you learned today, how would you view hard times and lives in the days ahead? (Hebrew 11:11, 17-19, 32-37).

Summary: We are strengthened when God demonstrate His power over situations and circumstances. It must be noted, however that is not in all cases that such manifestations can result in what we may call success or victory. Those who defiles the wickedness of their day, even at a cost to their lives, manifested living faith in God. (Heb. 11:36-38).
