

#### **COMMUNITY BIBLE STUDY**

### Sandra Hayes will depict the Book of Esther

**Date**: 1/20/20 **Time**: 7P.M. **Venue**: Parish Hall. **Instructor**: Mr. John Moore

Morning by Morning he wakens me and opens my understanding to His will. Isaiah 50:4

- **THEME**: The Manifestation of God's Power.
  - **TOPIC**: Hindrances to Prayer
- **TEXT**: James 1:5-7; John 15:7-10; Daniel 10:10-13; Ephesian 6:10-16

#### **AIMS: To learn:**

- 1. Inspiration for prayer that delights God' heart for daily living.
- 2. Inspiration for a praying Faith that gets results.

**INTRODUCTION:** It can feel like a defeat sometimes, feel like beating my head against the wall, repetitive, self-indulgent, short, dry, empty and seemingly unanswered, but, prayer is the key to the Kingdom of God and it delights His heart. As you know, when things are good, or when we have plenty, or distracted, God's get little of our time. When we do pray, our prayers are often filled with a wish list of things I want. Instead of being a time of communion with our Savior, prayer becomes a means to an end, and that end is **self**. This is common problem for many Christians. Therefore, what can hinder or delay our prayers according to the Scripture.

#### **STUDY GUIDE:**

- 1. Ignoring God's Word (Proverbs 28:9).
- 2. Loving Sin (Psalm 66:18).
- 3. Desiring Wrongly (James 4:2-3)
- 4. Doubting God (James 1:5-7; Romans 8:32).
- 5. Reason why prayers are delayed (Daniel 9:23; 10:10-13; Jude 1:9; Rev. 12:7; Ephesians 6:12).
- 6. Prayer that gets Results: (John 15:7-10, Ephesians 6:10:16, Daniel 9; 10)

**CONCLUSION**: Yes, we will still struggle with the flesh and the world; therefore, our requests may be tainted, and our ability to notice God's answers may be clouded. So, we cling to Psalm 37:4: "Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart. "Jesus has changed those who love him, delighting us in himself. Even when we don't know how to ask or receive, he sees what we truly want—to know him, love him, and bear fruit for him—and knows how and when to provide and answer.

**FOOD FOR THOUGHT**: "Take delight in the Lord, and he will give you the desires of your heart."

MEMORY VERSE: ("Psalm 37:4)
